
As we go into 2024, please know that I am committed to working hard for the reasons that make our district the best place to live and raise our families.

2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

- A Rep. La Chica played a key role to finally establish comprehensive regulations on e-cigarettes, an effort that took 9 years of youth advocacy.
- Rep. La Chica secured \$11.6 million in funding for Central Oahu schools and direct aid for community organizations serving District 37.





CONSTITUENT MATTERS

- Parks Department and the Mayor's Office to reopen and repaint the Mililani Outdoor Hockey Rink in April.
- Rep. La Chica worked diligently with property managers, condo boards, and the City's Department of Planning and Permitting to assist District 37 residents with various repair and renovation projects.
- **C** Rep. La Chica continues to collaborate with the U.S. Army Garrison Hawaii to prevent encampments from forming in the Kipapa Gulch area.
- Rep. La Chica's office has been to hazardous trees, tall grass, and invasive growth around the district.

BIG COMMUNITY WINS FOR DISTRICT 37

- **D** In July, more than 100 residents participated in the "Reimagining Public Safety"community event to learn how to take action and prevent crime in our neighborhoods. Honolulu Police Chief Joe Logan, Mayor Rick Blangiardi and the Office of the Attorney General and the Waikele Community Association supported the event.
- **E** In August, upon learning of the cancellation of school bus services across Central Oahu, Rep. La Chica took immediate action. She worked with affected families, community leaders, and the Department of Education to restore the service. Through her efforts, out of the 61 canceled routes, the Koa Ridge school bus was restored. Rep. La Chica remains committed to finding solutions for the remaining routes.
