



#### Peace on Your Wings - A Story of Resilience and Remembrance

In July, I had the honor of attending the opening night of *Peace* on Your Wings at the Kennedy Theatre at UH Manoa and even joined the cast in a meaningful pre-show circle. Created by Jennifer Taira and Laurie Rubin of 'Ohana Arts, the musical tells the story of Sadako Sasaki, a young girl whose paper cranes became a global symbol of peace after the Hiroshima bombing.

This year, 'Ohana Arts received a Grants-in-Aid award from the Legislature to help support their commemorative tour marking the 80th anniversary of the atomic bombings. My office was proud to support their efforts and help spotlight this Hawai'ibased production. The experience of watching it live was unforgettable - and a powerful reminder of the resilience and hope that can emerge from even the darkest moments.
